
## Knox Waverley Calisthenics Club Commitment Statement to Child Safety and Wellbeing

- We have Zero tolerance for child abuse or neglect.
- We prioritise the health, safety and well-being of children and young people over all other competing considerations.
- We are committed to taking the necessary steps to protect children and young people from harm by adopting a preventative, proactive and participatory approach to child safety.
- We promote positive interactions between participants, coaches and KWCC adults and their peers. These relationships are based on trust and respect.
- The development and confidence of every child and young person at KWCC is fostered through positive reinforcement and encouragement.
- We are committed to regularly reviewing our child safe practices and seeking input from our participants, families, coaches, and our governing body.
- We aim to ensure that all participants from different cultures (particularly those of Indigenous backgrounds) abilities, ethnicity, and sexuality are included and feel welcome at our club.
- We try to improve the experiences of vulnerable and marginalised children and young people within our community by opening encouraging participation at all levels.
- We undertake Working With Children Checks on all KWCC Adults working with Children.
- \* KWCC will continue to develop and review Codes of Conduct that all members must adhere to.
- Our leadership demonstrates commitment to child safety and leads by example, ensuring conduct towards children and young people is always respectful and transparent and by raising awareness through the club.
- We promote fairness and consideration for all coaches, volunteers, families, and participants.
